PRIZES

The creator of the winning submission will receive **\$50.00**. Creators of submissions meeting all of the rules and conditions below will receive one movie pass to the Narrow Gauge Cinemas.

OFFICIAL RULES

1. The contest is open to all full-time or part-time students enrolled at UMF for the Spring 2005 semester.
2. Contest entry is to be an original design for use on posters promoting the One Book, One Campus program. The artwork may be used on additional promotional materials, both print and electronic. The winner will be credited on all materials.
3. To be eligible for prizes, entries **must be** two dimensional, 9"x 9" in size, and submitted on paper or canvas or as an electronic file. (Acceptable electronic file formats are Photoshop, Illustrator, TIF, or EPS.) Submissions may be either black and white or color. They should **not** include "One Book, One Campus" or the title of the book, as they are already included on the poster.
4. The winning entry will become property of the University of Maine at Farmington. No artwork will be returned. The University retains the right to alter the image if deemed necessary.
5. Entries may be mailed or hand-delivered to: Shelly Davis, Mantor Library, 116 South St., Farmington ME 04938. All entries must be received no later than **Noon, February 11, 2005**. No late entries will be accepted. The winner will be announced shortly thereafter.
6. Entries will be judged on the basis of originality and suitability. Copyright compliance is expected. A panel of judges representing the sponsors will choose the winner. All decisions of the judges will be final.
7. Entries meeting all of the rules and conditions may be displayed in the library.
8. One grand prize will be awarded. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the judges. Mantor Library reserves the right to withhold all prizes in the event that no entries are deemed acceptable.
9. **All entries must be accompanied by this signed release form.**
